

# MARYLAND ACCESS POINT HOSPITAL TRANSITION PROGRAM

The **Maryland Department on Aging** partners with **Area Agencies on Aging (AAA)** Maryland Access Point providers to support older adults and adults with disabilities to successfully transition from a hospital setting back into the community and divert nursing home placement and re-hospitalization.

## EVIDENCE BASE

Hospital transition program outcomes include:

- An overall reduction in health care utilization after program enrollment.
- A 60% average decrease in hospital charges across all pre-post time blocks.
- 55% fewer enrollees experiencing a hospitalization after enrollment in the program, an annual cost savings of \$359,600, based on the average Medicare hospital cost.

## RETURN ON INVESTMENT

A national Return on Investment (ROI) calculator for hospital transitions showed an average **monthly savings of \$932 per person** and a local ROI calculator showed a **\$2.21 return for every dollar spent.**

## COSTS REDUCED

Embedding MAP **care coordination** and follow up at the point of discharge can divert **older adult patients and those with disabilities** from nursing homes and unnecessary hospital readmissions.
